Urban Butterfly Cards





Common Blue (Polyommatus icarus)
Family: Lycaenidae

Icarus is the most common urban butterfly in the family Lycenidae. Its small wings have a physical colouration, which varies according to the angle at which light strikes the wing scales, making it iridescent. In this species, males are blue, while females are brown, and thus easily distinguishable. All Lycenidae are predisposed to interact with ants (myrmecophily), through the production of sounds and chemicals.
